



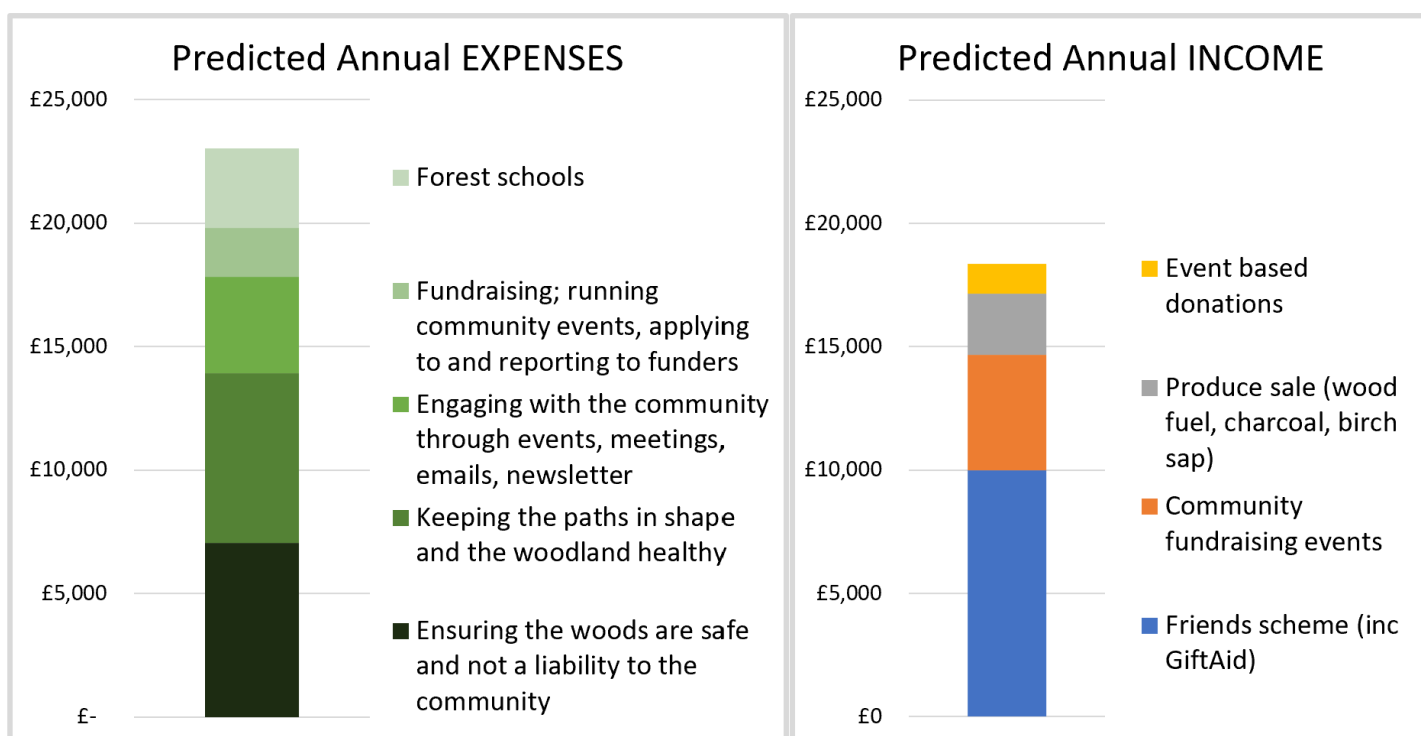
AGM Update & Cinema Plan...

September 2023

As you may be aware we recently held our Sixth AGM, and there was lots to report from the past year! We shared with attendees some of our key achievements over the past 12 months, which included:

- ◆ Over 1,800 hours of community volunteering have taken place!
- ◆ We've become the only fully accessible wood in Scotland (that we know of!).
- ◆ We've tackled Ash Dieback in our woods.
- ◆ We've new community groups using the woods in creative ways.

So what's next? As we enter the final year of our Heritage Lottery funding we also started to look forward at the AGM, and plan what happens next for our community woods. Based on our experience of looking after the woodland to date, the trustees have estimated the following costs and income streams.



We are incredibly grateful to everyone who continues to support the Woods. You will have noticed that the Expenses column is still a little higher than the Income, so we will have some decisions to make in the year ahead.

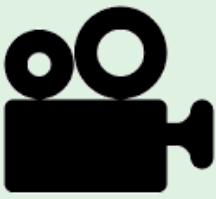

In other news...

The Fruit Trees have now been planted and were getting watered regularly by the volunteers over the dryer weeks, with thanks to our neighbours for the supply water.



Volunteer Days have continued, both with local groups and assistance from Lothian Conservation. These have tackled various tasks, including the continued battle against rhododendrons which can destroy native ecosystems when they are left unchecked.



Our very own Nev has led more **Fungi Forays** in the woods, with culinary support by Helle from Beech & Birch. Along with raising funds for the upkeep of our beautiful woods (nearly £600 at the last one alone!), the forays are a chance for the community to learn more about fungi, and specifically those found in our woods.

Dorothy Lyle has continued with more **A Meeting with Moths** events, where attendees learn about the moth population in the woods.

And indeed many thanks to the above and ALL our various volunteers who continue to run events, spend time with the school groups or help bring the Cubs into the woods for regular sessions.
